## **TOURNAMENT RULES AND INFORMATION**

- 1 This is a handicap play doubles tournament, first to 7 hoops
- 2 Format is "All PLAY ALL" within each block ( A - C)
- 3 The winning pair from each block will go through to the Play Off block
- 4 The 3 pairs in the Play Off block will play each other to determine the overall winner.
- 5 The winners of each block will be:
  - a) the pair which has won the most games
  - b) if there is then a tie between two or more pairs the winners will be the pair with the highest hoop difference.
  - c) if there is still a tie, the winner of the match between the pairs will be deemed the winner of the block.
  - d) Otherwise the tournament organiser, Graham Parker, will devise a tie break.
- 7 The winners of the play off block will be determined in a similar fashion.

## **HANDICAP PLAY**

- 1 The tournament will be played using Advantage Croquet system:
  - a) the mean handicap for each team is calculated as half the sum of the two handicaps in each pair with halves rounded up.
  - b) the starting score for each pair is then obtained from the table using the mean handicaps.
  - c) competitors should put pegs on appropriate rows of Advantage starting scores clipboard, and on each hoop they run, to enable scores to be checked at any time
